II

A. This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.

B. The specific purpose of this corporation is to promote the educational and interpretive activities of the Santa Clara County Parks and Recreation Department, principally in New Almaden Quicksilver County Park.

III

A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Service Code.

1. PUBLIC FORUMS TO ACQUIRE AND DISSEMINATE INFORMATION ABOUT THE PARK.
2. GUIDED TOURS, BOTH FREE AND FUND RAISING, OF THE HISTORIC AND GEOLOGICAL AREAS.
3. FUND RAISING ACTIVITIES TO RAISE REVENUE FOR A FUTURE INTERPRETIVE CENTER AND RANGER STATION.
4. TRAIL DAYS, FUND RAISING, TO HELP MAINTAIN THE VAST TRAIL SYSTEM THROUGHOUT THE PARK.

TO DATE THE PUBLIC FORUMS HAVE TAKEN THE FORM OF GENERAL MEETINGS WITH GUEST SPEAKERS. THE GUIDED TOURS HAVE BEEN LIMITED BECAUSE OF A LACK OF FACILITIES. THE FUND RAISING HAS BEEN LIMITED TO A MEMBERSHIP DRIVE. IN THE FUTURE THE ORGANIZATION WILL NEED TO DEVELOP A PLAN FOR RAISING REVENUE FOR A BUILDING PROJECT AND RESTORATION PURPOSES. THE TRAIL DAYS WILL CONTINUE TO OPERATE AND INCREASE IN NUMBER AND SIZE AS THE ORGANIZATION DEVELOPS.
